

EAR LOBE REPAIR/REDUCTION POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Clean incision lines (suture lines) with ½ and ½ mixture of hydrogen peroxide and distilled water to remove crusting 3 times per day. After cleaning, apply bacitracin antibiotic ointment to keep incision lines moist.
- 2. Use bacitracin ointment for the first 5 days after surgery, then switch to Aquaphor ointment as the bacitracin can become irritating.
- 3. You may shower, but do not get the incision lines wet. You may get the incision lines wet 3 days after surgery.
- 4. Please call immediately with any increased pain, redness, swelling, or fever.
- 5. If you are prescribed an antibiotic, please take as directed until finished. Do not drive if taking any narcotic pain medications.
- 6. It is very important to keep your wound protected from the sun while healing. Any sun exposure can worsen scarring. However, do NOT use sunscreen until instructed otherwise.
- 7. An appointment will be made for suture removal 1 week after surgery.
